She showed us how to actually use the microwave convection oven in our RVs. Janet scrambled eggs in seconds, put together a Pannekuchen (a pancake-type pastry) and a Blueberry Streusel Kuchen, all of which were absolutely delicious.

Janet also did a salmon filet and the most delicious moist meatloaf along with steamed asparagus.

To top it all off she made a quick and quite tasty spinach and artichoke pizza. What a different twist on pizza. All these items were available for sampling after the seminar.

Questions were answered to the satisfaction of all. If you have not sat in on one of these cooking seminars, I recommend you do at upcoming rallies. You will be amazed and satisfied with what you can do with your microwave convection oven.

The second session was a roundtable conversation. We discussed and added to the many items that come up daily with our motorhomes

such as what to do about smelly heads, keeping items on shelves while in motion, how to control those pesky bugs that like to bite and sting and keeping those rodents and ants from invading our privacy. Most of the items have been covered before but there were some new suggestions.

- Use Vodka to take up smelly pet mistakes.
- Use Listerine, undiluted, with some garlic added to keep the pesky bugs at bay.
- Add OdoBan (available at most big box retailers) to your head to keep aromas from coming into the RV.
- Microfiber cloths are wonderful for most any job you might encounter. Use them with just water to clean your windows, mirrors and to dry your shower after use. They even work better than a squeegee!
- We found that 20 Mule Team Borax is good for more than your laundry. Sprinkle it around the tires of your rig when you park to keep the ants from invading. Use it on red ant hills to discourage them.
